Eligible subjects of our institute are destined for those who want to broaden their perspective on Anatomy and its clinical applications (Clinical Anatomy, series of lectures by practicing clinicians, 2 credits, summer semester, year 1-5), or perfect their dissections and teaching skills as assistants/demonstrators during the courses of Anatomical Dissections 1 and 2 for the first year General Medicine students (**Practical Course of Topographical Anatomy 1, 2 (B81198, B81197)**, winter and summer semester, respectively); for the assistance with Dentistry students courses, there is an early summer semester course **Practical Course of Topographical Anatomy for Dentistry (B81945)** and **Practical Course of Orofacial Anatomy (B81199)**, taught to the 3rd year Dentistry students in the summer semester; for this one, Dentistry students are preferred.

For the advanced and experienced demonstrators with good teaching skills, there is a **Practical Course of Clinical Topographic Anatomy (B82092)**, which involves demonstrations in the Clinical Topographic Anatomy course for the 4th year students, at the beginning of the winter semester.

All students of the 2nd – 6th year interested in participation **as demonstrators** at the dissection courses are invited for selection tests, as the number of interested students historically exceeds our capacity about 3-4 times. The meetings usually take place at the **end of October** for the **winter** courses and in **March** for **summer** semester courses). A PowerPoint slide test covering subject matter of the course is used to match the number of applicants and available slots. Dates of the tests as well as the dates of the courses are announced through this web as well as the other Faculty channels (News, FB).
